Blood Lead Testing

Blood testing for children and adults

A small amount of blood is collected and then sent to a certified laboratory for testing. The test results are sent back to the parents and the physicians at the health clinic.

Water Testing

The Wayne Clinic located at 33030 Van Born Road has water bottles available for lead testing. Residents can come to the clinic, pick up a bottle, collect the water sample, package it, and then send the sample to the State water laboratory which charges a fee of \$18 for the water lead test.

These supplies can be picked up at the Venoy entrance of the Wayne Clinic. Test results are available within 7 days.
