Joseph Weekley – DPD officer charged with Involuntary Manslaughter in connection with the death of Aiyana Stanley-Jones. A trial date was scheduled today before Judge Cynthia Gray Hathaway for December 4, 2013, at 9:00 a.m.

Lavere Bryant - Defendant charged in Dearborn Family Dollar Store double homicide. At the request of the defense, his preliminary examination was previously adjourned until October, 1, 2013 in 19th District Court. He has also been charged with Sex Offender – Failure to Comply with Reporting Duties. He will be arraigned on the information on Thursday, August 22, 2013 at 9:00 a.m. before Judge James Chylinski in the Frank Murphy Hall of Justice.

Thursday, August 22, 2013

Lavere Bryant - Defendant charged in Dearborn Family Dollar Store double homicide. At the request of the defense, his preliminary examination on the homicide was previously adjourned until October, 1, 2013, in 19th District Court. He has also been charged with Sex Offender – Failure to Comply with Reporting Duties. Bryant was arraigned on the information today; there will be a calendar conference on August 30, 2013 before Judge Dana Hathaway.

Warrant Denied in Dillon Matter

Carol Dillon, the ex-wife of State Treasurer Andrew Dillon, filed a complaint alleging that, on July 13, 2013, at approximately 5:30 p.m., Mr. Dillon assaulted her outside of a house where she was residing in Redford Township. On July 15, 2013, the Redford Township Police Department submitted a warrant request to the Wayne County Prosecutor's Office regarding the allegations. After a thorough review of the evidence, it has been determined that there is insufficient evidence to file criminal charges. The warrant request has been denied.
