Roger Bowling – Defendant charged in connection with the double homicide and dismemberment of an Allen Park couple. The jury has been selected and opening arguments will begin tomorrow before Judge Ulysses Boykin.

Wednesday, August 13, 2014

Calvin Mosby and Devaunte Starks – Defendants charged in the fatal shooting death of an eight-year-old boy on East Street. Today the preliminary examination was adjourned until September 4, 2014 at 1:30 p.m.

Eric Chandler, Devon Berry, Clarence Moore, Jr., and Rodney Jean Richards – Defendants charged in connection with the carjacking and fatal shooting of Dontae Norris on Rutland Street. The preliminary examination was adjourned until Monday, August, 18, 2014.

Thursday, August 14, 2014

Theodore Wafer – Defendant convicted in the fatal shooting of Renisha McBride. The Court has adjourned the Wafer sentencing to September 3, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. before Judge Dana Hathaway.

Friday, August 15, 2014

Detroit Man and Woman Charged in Coplin Street Homicide

Prosecutor Kym L. Worthy has charged Brandi Wilson, 19 (DOB: 12/9/94) and Jamal McNabb, 20 (DOB: 6/6/93) with Felony Murder, First Degree Premeditated Murder and Felony Firearm in connection with the death of Sean J. Mathis, 37, all of Detroit. On July 31, 2014, at approximately 12:20 a.m., police were dispatched to a location in the 2590 block of Coplin where a dead body was found in the trunk of a burned car. An investigation by the Detroit Police Department led to the arrest of the two defendants. It is alleged that the defendants robbed the victim of his personal property, shot him multiple times and placed his body in the trunk a car in a lot near a vacant school in the 2590 block of Coplin.

The defendants are expected to be arraigned on Saturday, morning in 36th District Court. Please confirm the time with the court.
