### **Monday, February 3, 2014**

Anthony Fortson - Defendant charged in connection with an incident of forcefully taking a 15-year-old girl into a vehicle in Detroit. She escaped in Hamtramck by running to the home of a stranger, who called the police. Today the preliminary examination was adjourned until Wednesday, February 5, 2014 at 1:30 p.m. before Judge Alicia Jones-Coleman.

### **Wednesday, February 5, 2014**

Chauncey Owens and Charles Jones - Charged in the homicide of high school student Je'rean Blake. Closing arguments are expected to take place tomorrow after the defense rests.

Cass Tech High School Football Player – The Wayne County Prosecutor's Office continues to review the warrant request. This process involves interviewing witnesses and evaluating evidence. We do not expect to have a decision for several days. You will be updated when the review process is completed and a decision has been made.

### **Thursday, February 6, 2014**

Sanford McQueen and Karen Marie Geletzke – Defendants charged in connection with the death of a one-year-old child left in their care by his mother. Today the preliminary examination was adjourned until March 19, 2014 at 1:30 p.m. because documents from the medical examiner were not yet available.

Roderick Neely – Defendant charged with Torture, Assault with Intent to Maim and Assault with Intent to Commit Criminal Sexual Conduct and Felony Firearm for allegedly abducting, beating and using a blow torch to burn a woman's feet. At the request of the defense, the preliminary examination was adjourned until February 13, 2014 at 10:00 a.m.

Joseph Weekley – Detroit Police officer charged in the fatal shooting death of Aiyana Stanley-Jones during a police raid. There will be a pre-trial conference will be held on February 28, 2014 at 9:00 a.m.
