Taylor Man Charged in Home Invasion and Sexual Assault

On August, 29, 2015 Prosecutor Kym L. Worthy has charged Jeremy Rozycki, 23 (DOB: 6/19/92), of Taylor, with Home Invasion First Degree, two counts of Criminal Sexual Conduct First Degree, Child Abuse Third Degree and Aggravated Stalking. On August 28, 2015 at 10:30 p.m., it is alleged that Rozycki broke into the Taylor home of his 23-year-old ex-girlfriend, located in the 11700 block of Pine Street. While in the home he is alleged to have sexually assaulted the woman and assaulted their three-year-old daughter.

Rozycki was arraigned this morning before Judge Geno D. Salomone in 23rd District Court in Taylor. The Probable Cause Hearing is scheduled for September 9, 2015 at 12:55 p.m.; the Preliminary Examination is scheduled for September 14, 2015 at 12:55 p.m., both before Judge Geno Salomone. The defendant received a \$500,000 cash/surety bond.

Wednesday, September 2, 2015

Richard Wershe - We have been informed today that his Motion for Re-sentencing will heard before Judge Dana Hathaway on Friday, September 4, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. The defendant will be present in court. Erin Justice – Defendant charged in connection with the homicide of Alicia Marie Fox. The Court has put this case on the docket for Friday, September 4, 2015 at 8:30 a.m. for a special pre-trial conference. Judge Lawrence Talon has moved the start of the trial up a day; jury selection will begin on Tuesday, September 8, 2015 at 8:30 a.m.

Thursday, September 3, 2015

Drequone L. Rich – Defendant charged in connection with the murder of French street artist Bilal Berrini. Rich pleaded guilty to Second Degree Murder with a sentence agreement of 23-40 years before Judge Bruce U. Morrow. Defendant, Dionte Travis, will have jury selection next Tuesday, September 8, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. before visiting Judge Dalton Roberson. Testimony is expected to begin on September 10, 2015 at 9:00 a.m.

Derick Felton – Defendant charged in connection with possessing dogs that attacked and severely injured Steven Constantine. Felton pled guilty today as charged to three counts of Dangerous Animals Causing Injury (maximum four-year penalty.) The sentence hearing is scheduled for Friday, September 25, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. before Judge Michael Callahan.

Friday, September 4, 2015

Richard Wershe – Today Judge Dana Hathaway granted the Motion for Re-sentencing. Wershe will be re-sentenced on Friday, September 18, 2015 at 9:00 a.m.

Erin Justice – Defendant charged in connection with the homicide of Alicia Marie Fox. The court set the case on the docket for Friday, September 4, 2015 at 8:30 a.m. for a special pre-trial conference. Earlier today the defendant declined a plea offer reducing his to First Degree Murder charged to Second Degree Murder with a sentence agreement of 45 to 80 years and to two years consecutive for the Felony Firearm charge. The defendant changed his mind and at approximately 10:20 a.m. and pleaded guilty to the sentence agreement. Judge Lawrence Talon will sentence Justice on September 22, 2015 at 9:00 a.m.
