Detroit Police Officer Deloma Stone, 38, has been charged with Possession of a Firearm Under the Influence, a misdemeanor with a 93-day maximum penalty. On February 23, 2015 at approximately 8:30 p.m. at a bar located in the 1800 block of East 8 Mile Road, it is alleged that Officer Stone was intoxicated while carrying her department issued weapon. Bothuell Case - Parents charged with Torture and Child Abuse - Second Degree in connection the alleged abuse of their then 12-year-old son Charlie Bothuell V, who was isolated in the basement of their home. Today the case was set for preliminary examination on March 27, 2015 at 11:00 a.m. before Judge Shannon Holmes. The Judge reduced both defendants' bonds to \$50,000/10%, GPS tether and no contact with minor children, or the family and extended family of young Charlie Bothuell.
