## **NEWS UPDATES**

### **Tuesday, March 10, 2015**

Andrew Jackson – Defendant charged in carjacking and robbery of woman at gunpoint while her grandchildren were in the car. Today Jackson was arraigned before Judge Michael Hathaway and a final conference has been set for June 1, 2015 at 9 a.m. The jury trial is scheduled for June 8, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. for jury selection and opening statements are scheduled to begin June 9, 2015 at 9:00 a.m.

The Wayne County Prosecutor's independent investigation relating to the arrest and apprehension of Jackson by the ACTION task force remains under review.

### **Thursday, March 11, 2105**

#### **Detroit Man Charged in Monica Street Stabbings**

Prosecutor Kym Worthy has charged Jeremiah Edwards, 33 (8/13/15) of Detroit, with Home Invasion, three counts of Assault with Intent to Murder, one count of Assault with Intent to do Great Bodily Harm, three counts of Felonious Assault and one count of Domestic Violence Assault and Battery in connection with stabbing three women and one man.

On March 10, 2015, at approximately 11:05 p.m. at a home in the 12100 of Monica in Detroit, it is alleged that Edwards hit his 34-year-old girlfriend in the eye when she asked him to leave the home. He briefly left the house but forced his way back in and stabbed another woman in the forehead and stabbed a man in the shoulder. While they were incapacitated, it is alleged that he

ran up to his girlfriend and stabbed her in the hand and then stabbed the male victim in the stomach. The woman who was stabbed in the forehead got a shovel and hit Edwards with it several times before she fled from the house on foot. The Detroit Police were called to the scene and arrested the defendant in a nearby alley near in the 14000 block of Santa Rosa. The victims were taken to a local hospital where they were treated for their wounds.

Edwards is expected to be arraigned today at 2:30 p.m. in 36<sup>th</sup> District Court. Please confirm the arraignment time with the court.

Mariah Pisarski – Defendant was an accessory after the fact in the homicide of a 76-year-old Plymouth Township man. Today she was sentenced by Judge Slavens to two to five years in prison on the charges of accessory after the fact to a felony and larceny of firearms. Co-Defendant Andrew Nutt will be sentenced tomorrow before Judge Slavens at 9:00 a.m.

Evan Reed - Former Tiger pitcher charged with sexually assaulting a woman. He will be arraigned on the information tomorrow at 9:00 a.m. before Judge Shannon Walker.

Bassel Saad – Soccer player who pled guilty to Manslaughter in the fatal assault on a referee at an adult soccer game. He is scheduled to be sentenced before Judge Thomas Cameron tomorrow at 9:00 a.m.

### **Detroit Man Charged in Monica Street Stabbings**

Prosecutor Kym Worthy has charged Jeremiah Edwards, 33 (8/13/15) of Detroit, with Home Invasion, three counts of Assault with Intent to Murder, one count of Assault with Intent to do Great Bodily Harm, three counts of Felonious Assault and one count of Domestic Violence Assault and Battery in connection with stabbing three women and one man.

On March 10, 2015, at approximately 11:05 p.m. at a home in the 12100 of Monica in Detroit it is alleged that Edwards hit his 34-year-old girlfriend in the eye when she asked him to leave the home. He briefly left the house but forced his way back in and stabbed a **12-year-old female** victim in the forehead and stabbed a **16-year-old male** victim in the shoulder. While they were incapacitated, it is alleged that he ran up to his girlfriend and stabbed her in the hand and then stabbed the 16-year-old male in the stomach. Edwards then kicked an **11-year-old girl** in the stomach. The 16-year-old male who was stabbed in the stomach and shoulder got a shovel and hit Edwards with it several times before the defendant fled on foot from the house. The Detroit Police were called to the scene and arrested the defendant in a nearby alley near in the 14000 block of Santa Rosa. The victims were taken to a local hospital where they were treated for their injuries.

Edwards was arraigned today and was remanded to jail. His Probable Cause Hearing is scheduled for 8:30 a.m. on March 20, 2015 and his Preliminary Examination is scheduled for March 27, 2015 at 9:00 a.m.

**Detroit Police Officer Charged with Theft**

Prosecutor Kym L. Worthy has charged Detroit Police Officer Christos Kyriakides, 62, with Larceny in a Building. On February 20, 2015 at approximately 8:20 p.m., it is alleged that Officer Kyriakides participated in the execution of a search warrant and, while at the location, removed a framed Scarface movie collage from the scene and placed it in his scout car and later concealed it in his personal vehicle.

He is expected to be arraigned today in before in 36<sup>th</sup> District Court at 10:30 a.m. According to the court computer, the arraignment will be held in 36<sup>th</sup> District Courtroom 440.
