Wayne County Department of Public Services Announces Upcoming Auction

Vehicles, Equipments and other unique items will be up for auction on Oct. 3, 2015

BROWNSTOWN TWP, MI – The equipment division of the Wayne County Department of Public Services will host an equipment auction on Sat., Oct. 3, 2015 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. inside Martin's Towing at 17180 Dix-Toledo Rd. in Brownstown Twp. A preview of the auction items will take place Fri., Oct. 2 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Some of the 180 items up for auction include a 16-foot Zodiac boat with a 25 mph motor, farm tractors, snow plow trucks, a wood chipper, a bulldozer, and two Homeland Security shower trailers. In addition, there will be several cars, trucks, and SUVs available.

Anyone who would like to participate can pay the \$200 bidding deposit (cash only) the day before or the day of the auction. Guests who do not bid will be refunded their deposit.

Wayne County holds this auction annually to dispose of items that are no longer useful to the County but may be to someone else.

Proceeds from the auction will be deposited into the various department fund accounts that originally paid for the equipment or vehicles.
