

## What You Must Bring to Get Your Taxes Done:

- Social Security Card & Cards for all claimed dependents\* (Originals Only)
- Valid Picture ID (Driver's License or State ID)

### Proof of Income:

- Wages (all Forms W-2), Miscellaneous Income (Form 1099-Misc)
- Unemployment (Form 1099-G)
- Gambling/Lottery Winnings (Form W-2G)
- Pension (Form 1099-R)
- Social Security Benefit Form (Form 1099-SSA)
- Supplemental Security Income (Form 1099-SSI/Form 1099-SSD),  
• or Letter from SSA
- Social Security Disability (1099-SSDA)
- VA total monthly benefit or sum for the year from the Dept. of Veterans Affairs
- Interest and Dividends (Form 1099-INT and/or 1099-DIV)
- DHS Cash Assistance (DHS Annual Statement)
- Other relevant information about income

### Proof of Expenses:

- Medical or HMO Premiums paid for self and/or family dependents
- Total amount paid for day care and the day care provider's tax identification number
- Student Loan Interest (1099E), Tuition (1098T) & course material receipts

### Home and Heating Credit:

- Total amount of residential heating costs paid in 2014 (amount is located on December 2014, January 2015 or February 2015 gas bill)

### Homeowners:

- Proof of taxable value of your home and summer/winter property taxes for 2014
- Mortgage Interest (form 1098)

### Renters:

- Lease or rental contract and rent receipts for 2014
- Landlord's name, address & zip codes

### For Direct Deposit:

- Bank or Credit Union name, routing number and account number

### Proof of Medical Insurance Coverage

- Form 1095-A (Health Insurance Marketplace Statement)
- Exemption Certification Number (Provided by the Marketplace)

### Other Relevant Information:

- Copy of last year's federal and state tax returns
