Documents to bring with you:

If available, a record of vaccines the child has already received

Health insurance card

If applicable, cash or check to pay for pediatric and adult vaccines

If applicable, cash or check to pay for Flu vaccines which are \$20

NOTE: For pediatric clients, services will not be denied for an inability to pay for pediatric vaccines

Must have Valid State of Michigan Photo ID

Juvenile Prevention Services

Learn about program services offered through our Prevention Network; Assisting families or individuals with understanding how to navigate the process for At-Risk complaints for prevention services; Identify the appropriate agency/provider based on their geographic location and need.

Veteran Services

Provide potential grants for emergency needs (i.e. shut off notice DTE bills, past due rent, past due mortgage payments);
